

Tuition Tax Credit Scholarship List

In Arizona, a taxpayer can make a contribution to a tuition tax credit scholarship organization. They will receive a tax credit that reduces their tax liability, dollar for dollar. Donations can be made up to \$1089 for a single tax payer and \$2177 for a married couple (tax year of 2017 rates). Taxpayers are usually allowed to recommend a specific school or a particular student who will receive the tuition assistance. In other words, the tax dollars that you would normally pay to the state of Arizona can come to the Academy to help pay tuition for a student*.

Empowerment Scholarship of Arizona

This scholarship is specifically for children who:

- *Are military dependents*
- *Were in a public school last year and have a 504 plan or IEP*
- *Student is/has been a ward of the juvenile court*
- *Student's parent is legally deaf or blind, or hard of hearing*

Applications are ongoing. Once awarded, the State provides a debit card to you to pay your tuition. For 2017, Parents were awarded full tuition for grades 1-8, and partial tuition for Kindergarten (near \$3000). The ESA scholarship is renewable for each subsequent year. There is a bill pending to allow for the expansion of this program. This has been tabled until a vote in November 2018.
