Summer School Letter to Parents

Dear parent(s) and summer school attendees,

We are so excited to welcome you to First Baptist Christian Academy summer school. Your children are going to have a fun and educational summer. With that being said, we do have a few reminders that we would like to send you:

*Participation in daily activities is required for all grade levels. Your child may like some of the activities more than others, however, the expectation is that each child participates if they attend. Children should attend with positive attitudes and good spirits for each day they are here.

*The dress code for summer school is not as strict as during the school year, but there are still some restrictions. Close toes shoes are required (except during water play). Shorts must not be shorter than the child's fingertips when the child's hands are resting by their sides. No strappy or open back tank tops will be permitted. Any logo or design must be appropriate for Christian School.

*Swim attire during Friday water play for girls will include one piece and tankini's. A two piece will be permitted only if covered by a shirt. Boys are also required to wear a shirt with their swim trunks to protect from the sun. **Please bring towels and a change of clothes (including undergarments).**

*There will not be a designated First Aid Specialist throughout the summer. We will not be able to apply sunscreen to your child so **Please ensure they come to school with sunscreen on each day.** Your child may be outside 1-2 hours per day, so please also have them dressed accordingly. Also, any medications will need the appropriate form filled out and kept in the office. Children may not have any medications or sunscreen on them at any time.

*Electronics will not be permitted during our day, so please keep all your electronic devices (tablets, phones, Nintendo's, iPad, or other devices) at home. We will use the computer lab if we need to incorporate electronic time.

***Breakfast and Lunch will be provided Monday-Friday.** We will also be providing an afternoon snack and a special snack during our movie time.

*For preschool through 1st grades we ask that you send a change of clothes including undergarments in case your child has an accident during the day.

2020 Summer Tuition and Fee

(May 26 through July 24)

Summer Program with extended care (6:30 am- 5:30 pm)

Tuition for the summer program will be \$140.00 per week regardless of days attending.

Details:

1. Current Students will be billed through FACTS.
2. New parents will need to pay in the office each week. Monthly payments are also accepted.
3. We require a 10-day written notice when withdrawing a student from the summer program. If notice is not given within this time, you will be responsible for the paying the 10 days prior tuition.
4. If tuition has not been paid by the end of the month, the child may not attend the program until it is paid.

Additional Costs:

Activities and Supplies Fee: \$40 non-refundable due at registration

Late Tuition:

\$30 late fee per child

Returned Check Fee: \$35 if insufficient fund check is received; only cash or credit will be accepted as payment.

Weekly Activities

*Monday-Thursday we will have our classes. We will incorporate Curriculum, Art, Music, Bible, and PE. Learning with different ways including but not limited to computer lab, art projects, nature walks, games, etc.

*Breakfast is from 8:30-9:30 and we will have 30 minutes after to go outside and play as the weather should still be cooler.

*Lunch is from 11:30-12:30 and then depending on weather we will have 15-30 minutes outside.

*Afternoon snack is at 3:30

*One day during our week Lees Karate will be coming in to teach our kids karate. Also, a dance teacher will come on another day to teach the children dance. Desert Thunder gymnastics will come one day and do an exhibition/class.

*Friday is our fun day. A water slide and jumping castle will be provided after our breakfast time and go until 30 minutes before lunch. After lunch recess we will be having a movie. All movies being shown are rated G. You may also send your child with a sleeping bag, pillow, or stuffed animals to use during our movie time.

1. I will faithfully support FBCA through my prayers and positive attitude. If an issue arises that I need to address, I will utilize the guidelines found in Matthew 18:15. I agree not to include anyone in a discussion of such an issue, unless that person is involved directly. The school principal will address any unresolved issues if necessary.
2. I acknowledge that my child's initial enrollment at FBCA is without restriction unless I am notified separately that enrollment is probationary. I realize that several factors could cause a change in enrollment status. The factors include but are not limited to 1. An administrative decision to withdraw a child's enrollment or place him or her on probationary enrollment, based on grades, readiness test scores, or a discipline matter; 2. A revision in class structure, based on financial situations and or Academy Board decisions.
3. I will withdraw my child from the Academy if requested to do so. The Academy is under no obligation to provide justification other than it is in the best interest of the academy.
4. Tuition must be current for my child to attend class. Currents student's tuition is paid to FACTS Management at the chosen date you provided when originally signing up. **I understand that there are no discounts given for my child being absent or for school holidays.** A late charge of \$30.00 will be applied for any late payments per child. If tuition had not been paid by the end of the month, my child may not attend class until the account has been brought current. If the services of a collection agency are required to collect past due tuition, I understand I will be required to pay such costs. I also understand that if I write two non-sufficient checks to the Academy, I will be required to pay all tuition and other fees by cash or certified check from that point forward. Students outside FBCA will need to make payment arrangements with the office.
5. My child will adhere to the dress code: See summer school letter to parents.
6. I authorize the school to conduct unannounced inspections of my child's backpack, cubby, or desk.
7. I authorize the school to administer such disciplinary measures as may be deemed necessary and proper by the administration. The Academy does not use Corporal Punishment. If a problem arises between your student and another student, first report the incident to your child's teacher or the Principal. Parents are not to discuss or talk with the other student without their parents being present.
8. First Baptist Christian Academy is not responsible for any accidents on the school campus or field trips. Medical bills resulting from injuries to my child will be paid for by my insurance. Deductibles, co-pays, or other costs not covered by my insurance will be submitted to the Academy for submission to their insurance company. The Academy carries insurance as required by the State of Arizona.
9. I do hereby agree and understand First Baptist Christian Academy and First Baptist Church are not responsible, and therefore not liable in any manner for lost, missing, stolen, or damaged personal electronic items such as cellphones, tablets, laptops, etc. Any student bringing any personal items to school does so at his/her own personal risk. No monies shall be paid to any student or parents making a claim or the loss or damage of such items.
10. I authorize the First Baptist Christian Academy to take my child, _____
On field trips to places of interest by means of automobile, bus, or on foot. Permission forms must be signed for each trip more than a block from the school property. (For our policy regarding volunteer drivers for field trips, please see the Parent Handbook).
11. **I will give the Academy 10 days written notice prior to withdrawing my child from school. If I fail to give the written notice at least 10 days in advance, I will pay tuition for 10 days following the last day of my child's attendance at the Academy (if no notice was given) or for 10 days following the day that I did give the notice.**
12. I understand the First Baptist Christian Academy is a faith-based organization and that its curriculum, teaching methods, and operating decisions are based on its mission statement and statements of faith. I agree not to refute the school mission statement or statements of Faith publicly, and will support the school in its program, academic, and disciplinary policies.

13. I understand that my child may be photographed or videotaped directly or indirectly by our school photographer representatives to upgrade our school's website and for promotional material such as, printed fliers, brochures, and yearbooks. I also understand that I must submit a written request if I do not want my child photographed.
